Information and instructions for pupils.

Timetable

Highlight the exams you will be taking during the mock exam period and enter them into your homework diary in case you lose this sheet. If there is a choice of rooms for an exam your subject teacher will tell you which room to go to. You need to write the room on this sheet and in your homework diary.

Exam Leave

During the mock exams, if you are up to date on coursework, you will have exam leave and will only come to school when you have an exam. If you owe any coursework in any subject your exam leave will not start until you are up to date and you will come to school all day every day to complete your coursework in the study room. Miss Doran and Mr Downward will be compiling a list of these pupils over the next few weeks and will let you know if you do not qualify for study leave.

Registration and attendance

During the examination period you will not go to registration. We expect full attendance at all exams, like the real GCSEs. If you are *really* poorly you must ring Miss Doran to discuss rearranging your exam for another day.

Exam Times

For morning exams you should go straight to your exam room at 8.30am.

For exams after break go to your exam room at 11.05am.

For afternoon exams go to your exam room at 2.00pm.

Equipment

You should bring all your own equipment (black pens, pencils, eraser, ruler, compasses, angle measurer, calculator) in a clear pencil case or plastic wallet. You will also be given a small card on which to write your name and form. You should place this card on your exam desk so teachers can complete a register as they walk around the room in silence.

Art Exams

The Art mock exams will take place on Tuesday 8th December and Wednesday 9th December in C15 and C17 (all day both days).

Language Oral Exams

Your language teacher will arrange a time for your mock oral exam. These will take place during the examination period in December and January at a time when you have no other exams. Make a careful note of the day, date, time and room. Remember you may take in a prompt card with 5 headings for your one minute presentation.
