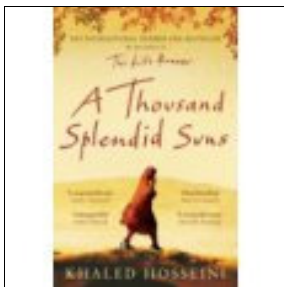

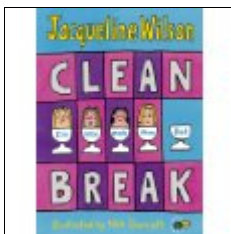
Mrs Bush has just finished reading

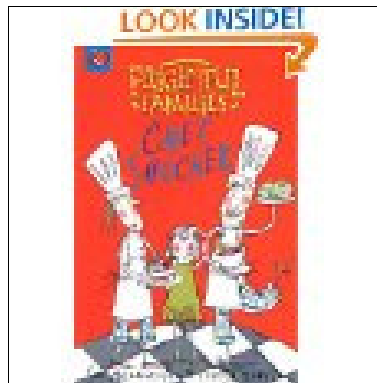
Clean Break by Jaqueline Wilson
